Dear parent/carer,

We are sorry to confirm but a pupil in the Yr11 Bubble tested positive for COVID-19.

In line with government guidance, they must immediately self-isolate at home for at least 10 days from when their symptoms started. To reduce the spread, we have sent home students that had come into close contact with them and they will be asked to stay at home for 14 days to self-isolate.

The bubble will remain open for other children so please ensure they attend school.

To clarify, the student that has been told to self-isolate is the student that tested positive for COVID19 in Year 11.

Any student in year 11 that has been in close contact, with that year 11 student has also been sent home to self-isolate. There is no need, for any other student in any other year group bubble to self-isolate and should attend school as normal.
