RE: Enrichment offer November 2019

You will be aware that our enrichment programme offers our students extended opportunities for learning outside of the classroom. We have a great variety of activities on offer such as football club, baking, cross stitch, debate club, chess, photography club, dance, drama, golf and many more.

Following your feedback and as the cold and dark nights draw in, we agree that enrichment should not be compulsory for students, with immediate effect.

All activities will continue to run, instead on a voluntary basis for the students. In effect, this means that from Monday 2nd December 2019, the compulsory school day for Years 7-10 will finish at 3.15pm. Year 11 will continue with intervention on both Monday and Tuesday until 4.05pm. Students in Year 7-10 not continuing with enrichment activities should leave the school site promptly at 3.15pm.

This will not affect the buses, they will continue to arrive at the end of the enrichment period (4.05pm) until the Christmas break and therefore your child will not be disadvantaged. During the coming weeks, will communicate with the bus company around the bus schedule to ensure that we have the best solution for moving forward following the Christmas break.

To commit to continuing with enrichment until the end of term, please indicate your child's enrichment activity on the day (s) that they wish to continue with this activity. This will be collected from your son/daughter on Thursday 28th November 2019 during morning line up.
