As a student you agree to:

- Wear the correct Academy uniform every day.
- Arrive on time to school and attend regularly.
- Bring the correct equipment with me every day to ensure I am ready for learning.
- Always have a reading book in my school bag to use during the school day.
- Be ready to learn and to have the correct attitude in class and complete all class work to the best of my ability
- Behave appropriately at all times, in line with the school ethos and values
- Work with others effectively and appropriately.
- Complete all homework to the best of my ability and hand it in to my subject teacher on time.
- I understand that if my mobile phone or any other electronic device is used, seen or heard during the school day it will be confiscated and my parent/carer will be able to collect it on Friday of that week.
- Go to the Academy office if you need to contact home and not use your own mobile phone
- Treat each member of Ark Alexandra, staff and students with respect and kindness at all times.
- Except responsibility for my actions and accept support that the school offers me.



As a parent/carer you agree to:

- Ensure that your child is prepared and ready for learning every day.
- Promote the values of the school and education generally as well as uphold all school policies. These include, but are not limited to, uniform/equipment, attendance and behaviour policies.
- Support the Academy on implementing our high expectations policy.
- Make every effort to support your child's learning at home.
- Inform the Academy of any circumstances that may affect your child's behaviour or ability to learn effectively.
- Communicate with members of staff with respect and kindness when calling, sending emails or in meetings.
- Contact the Academy Absence Line (01424 439888) by 8am every day to inform us of any unavoidable absence and continue to keep us informed until my child returns.
- Not take your child on holiday in term-time and ensure your child arrives promptly to school each day and attends regularly ensuring an overall attendance rate of 97% throughout the academic year.
- Your child's mobile phone or any other electronic device is to be turned off whilst on the Academy site. If they are used, seen or heard during the school day they will be confiscated and returned to the parent (or the student if they have a permission note) on Friday of that week.
- Only contact my child through the Academy Office and not contact them directly on their mobile phone.
- Understand and accept that the Academy has zero tolerance of students found in possession of any weapons, drugs, smoking and smoking paraphernalia and also confirm you understand that should your child be found in possession of any of these items it could lead to their permanent exclusion from the Academy.
- Attend meetings, including Parents' Evenings to discuss my child's progress in school.
- Get to know about my child's life at Ark Alexandra by reading, and where appropriate, responding to letters sent home.
- Make an appointment in advance if I need to speak to a teacher or senior member of staff, either by writing to or telephoning the school.
- Ensure my child attends any sanction, either during lunchtime, after school or within the school day.
