Despite the challenges, our students have persevered and have been resilient in their approach to their education. Families have had a considerable bearing upon this, and so you all deserve credit too.

The Headlines (during a pandemic):

- We delivered 100% of lessons live during the lockdown.
- We have sourced and delivered a Chrome Book device to every student to access home learning.
- We have our largest Sixth Form cohort starting in September.
- In the Sixth Form, we have four students aiming at Oxbridge & six applying to study Medicine.
- Over 400,000 golden tickets have been given out to recognise student achievement this year!
- Attendance has improved
- Students are showing their positive behaviours, wearing their uniform with pride and most importantly making progress in their studies
- We have had two very positive Ofsted inspections (the second report will be published in September)
- Staff turnover is at its lowest level for several years.
