Year 10 Religious Studies Revision Guide Letter

Dear parents/carers,

Since the last set of mock examinations in February, we have been tracking the progress of our Year 10 students.

After-school Intervention sessions

All students who are part of the year group have access to the after-school intervention sessions that take place during the week. This will depend on which subject they need more support in. These run between 3:15 and 4:15pm in the afternoon. The sessions are below:

Tuesday 3:15-4:15 WPL32

Friday 3:15-4:15 WPL33

Tutor Interventions

Selected students have been identified to attend tutor sessions with the subject lead, these are targeted sessions.

Intervention days -Easter

This session will run on **Friday 14th April**. Sometimes, due to numbers and staffing, students will be selected on a first come first serve basis. This day will involve revising some of the key topic areas either in paper 1 or 2 dependent on responses. A separate letter of invite will be sent to students identified.

Attendance and Behaviour

One of the key actions that the students can do to help with their grades, is to ensure that they attend school 100% of the time. The more time that they are in school and lessons, the more chance they have of achieving their grades. This also relates to being on time to the lessons. If a student is 5 minutes late to all of their lessons, then this is a considerable amount of time that they are missing. This also relates to their behaviour and the need to stay in their lessons at all times.

Revision strategies

As a department we would advise that students be revising at least 30mins to 1 hour a day, their teachers will inform them of the gaps from the recent mocks and assessments.





The following strategies could be used:

- Learning key vocabulary (as a parent /guardian you could help by testing them on these).
- Creating flash cards ([Online Flashcard Maker & Flashcard App | Quizlet](#)) -this is a useful online version.
- Using the knowledge organisers to create mind maps.
- Practice exam questions
- Using the school website to access the revision materials.
- Completing all Seneca tasks
